In the year 1952 there will be four eclipses, two of the Sun and two of the Moon.

1. A Partial Eclipse of the Moon on February 11th, visible in Great Britain.
2. A Total Eclipse of the Sun on February 29th, visible in Great Britain as a Partial Eclipse.
3. A Partial Eclipse of the Moon on August 6th. It is doubtful whether any part of this eclipse will be seen in Great Britain.
4. An Annular Eclipse of the Sun on August 20th, invisible in Great Britain.
